

Follows the regulations for the “Le Vie Francigene” Trenord offer

Via Francigena regulations valid until 31/12/2019



Trenitalia reserves a particular offer for the pilgrims of “Le Vie Francigene” who intend to conduct part of their pilgrimage utilising regional trains, valid for both 1st and 2nd class travel, in the regions of Valle D’Aosta, Piedmont, Liguria, Emilia Romagna, Tuscany and Lazio.

In particular, Trenitalia reserves:

- a 10% discount on the original fare, valid every day, to pilgrims in possession of the official European Association of Via Francigena Ways ‘Pilgrim Passport’. The offer may be combined with the child discount of 50% (4-12 years of age, except in the case of different regional regulations);
- the possibility for groups and parties* to pre-book seating aboard the train for 1,50€ per passenger, upon prior request at the Regional Directorate or the Provincial reference point.

**please note that pilgrim groups and parties are not included on trains and routes expressly indicated in the Official Trenitalia Timetable. The regulations of individual Regional or Provincial Directorates are available at www.trenitalia.com/Trasporto Regionale.*

In the case of travel with bicycles, pilgrims must have a valid travel document for the bicycle.

How to purchase a ticket

The discounted pilgrim ticket can be purchased at a ticket office, self-service machines, travel agencies authorised by Trenitalia and at trenitalia.com (excluding the Trenitalia app). [Find the purchase guide online at trenitalia.com.](#)

The stations, if equip with a ticket office, interested in the ‘Le Via Francigene’ route may apply a milestone stamp to Pilgrim Passports.

Documents to display to the conductor

A pilgrim, aboard the train or exiting the station, must be able to display both his/her train ticket and his/her Pilgrim Passport. Should he/she lack either one of these documents, the travel document will be considered invalid and he/she will be regulated in accordance with current legislation.

Although unspecified, all regulations included in the [Trenitalia Travel Conditions](#) remain valid.

Regulations for the “Le Vie Francigene” Trenord offer

An offer dedicated to the pilgrims of “Le Vie Francigene” is available on regional Trenord trains.

The offer is valid every day, in both 1st and 2nd class, on Trenord regional trains:

- a discount of 10% on the original fare to all pilgrims in possession of the ‘Pilgrim Passport’ issued through the official channels of the European Association of Via Francigena Ways. The offer cannot be combined with the child discount of 50% or senior discount of 20%;
- in the case of bicycles, the ordinary fare already in use will be applied in tow;
- pilgrim groups or parties are not included on trains or routes expressly indicated in the Official Trenord Timetable;

The discounted fare may be purchased:

Ticket offices interested in the “Le Vie Francigene” route may apply the milestone stamp to Pilgrim Passports.

Documents to display to the conductor

A pilgrim, aboard the train or exiting the station, must always be able to display his/her ticket and Pilgrim Passport to the train conductor. Should he/she lack one of these, the travel document will be invalid and he/she will be regulated in accordance with current legislation. Although unspecified all the regulations included in the General Passenger Transport Conditions of Trenord remain valid.
