The project

The "Thermal Via Francigena" project was born in the Tuscan section of the route in order to offer an additional service to travellers who wish to broaden their experience through a proposal devoted to their well-being.

The project aims to promote thermal structures in close proximity to the Francigena Way hoping to expand on an international level and to interact with European slow tourism.

Travellers can combine physical relaxation and thermal water with their journey. Thermal structures are committed to welcoming pilgrims with an offer linked to transport, hospitality and thermal treatment with favourable rates for pilgrims and tourists equipped with the European Association of Via Francigena Ways official "Pilgrim Passport".



Pilgrim's Offer

Each thermal facility involved in the projects offers a particular "pack" of services, including:

- Standard access to thermal services (access to thermal pools and treatment)
- An optional additional service (massage, sauna, Turkish bath among other services)

Thermal facilities also offer the following additional services to pilgrims:

- Free transport to the facility
- Designated bike storage
- Accommodation options at the accredited thermal facility
